



Regular Season & Post Season Format 2018

All Game Schedules, including post-season bracket games at the end of the regular season, can be found on [Tourney Machine](#).

Home Field for post-season games will be decided by the team who received the lesser # of regular season home games. Priority will be given to those teams that received fewer home games in the regular season. The second criteria will be field availability and the third consideration will be travel distance.

Pee Wee (3rd & 4th Grade Combined) and Jr. Midget (5th & 6th Combined):

Regular Season: Teams will be divided into 8 separate divisions. Each team will play a 6 game regular season. Every team will play games against each of the teams within their division, as well as teams from outside of their division. **The only games that will count for or against each teams' regular season record are the games against the other teams from within their division.**

Post Season: Each team will receive 2 post season games after the regular season is complete through a bracketing process. The 4th place team in the Pee Wee division of the Southwest Division will only receive 1 post-season game.

5th Grade and 6th Grade:

Regular Season: Teams will be divided into 2 separate divisions. Each team will play a 6 or 7 game regular season. Every team will play games against each of the teams within their division, as well as teams from outside of their division. **The only games that will count for or against each teams' regular season record are the games against the other teams from within their division.**

Post Season: Each team will receive a minimum of 1 post season game after the regular season is complete. The top 2 teams from each division at the conclusion of the regular season will compete for a chance to go to the league championship. The remaining teams will play in a Friendship Game against an opponent from the opposite division that finished in the same place. 2nd place Legends will play 2nd place Leaders, etc.

7th Grade:

Regular Season: Each team will play a 4 game regular season with each team receiving Bye Weeks. The teams will play a home and home game vs. each of the other teams in the division.

8th Grade:

Regular Season: Each team will play a 6 game regular season with each team receiving Bye Weeks. The teams will play a home and home game vs. each of the other teams in the division.
